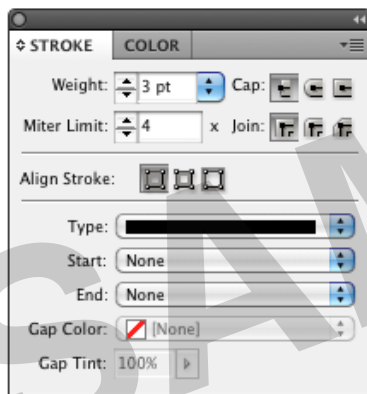
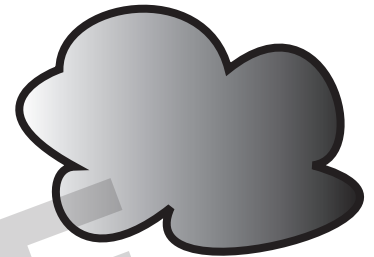
Stroke and Fill are two aspects of any texts or graphics that you can control while using InDesign.

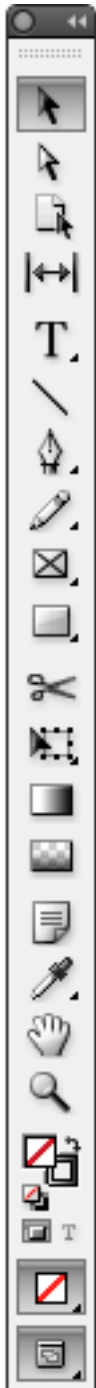
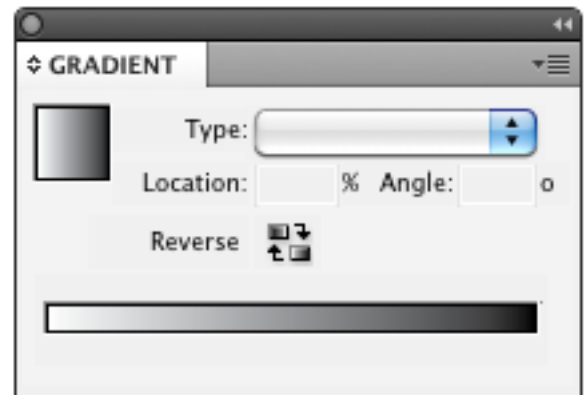
Use the shown Panels to make the 3 clouds below.



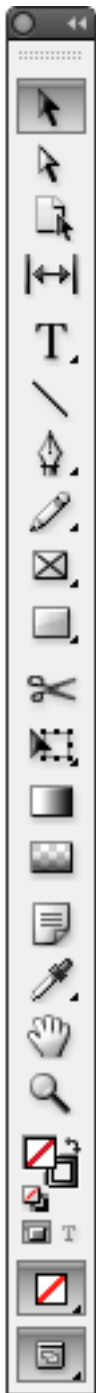
<--

Hover over to see which is which.



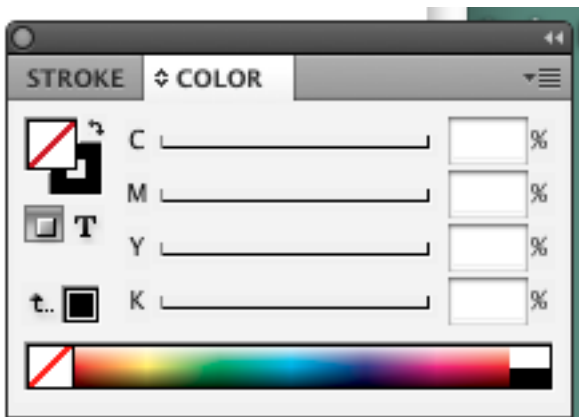
After you have finished with the clouds, use the type tool to create the examples you see below.



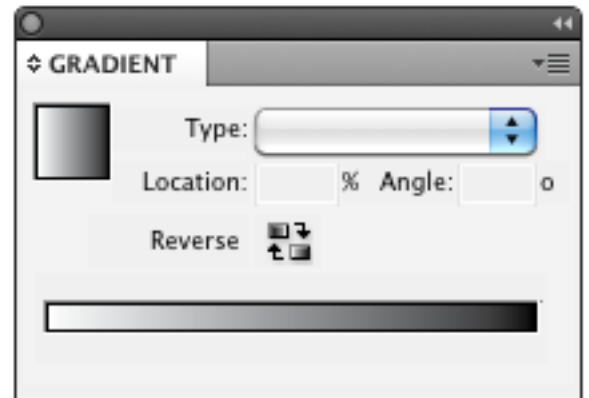
<-- Type Tool: select the tool. Click and drag then begin typing.
