

# Screen Printing Design

Ever walked into the store and thought “that shirt is lame!” “I could make a better design than that.” Well here is your chance...

Your design must be original line art. It should include a minimum of one vector image that is Spot Colored and some text that is Outlined. You can find and download fonts online. Dafont.com has been a good resource. Watch my demo to see how to do this.

## Project elements:

Your design should be approximately 8.5” x 11”

Must have one vector image

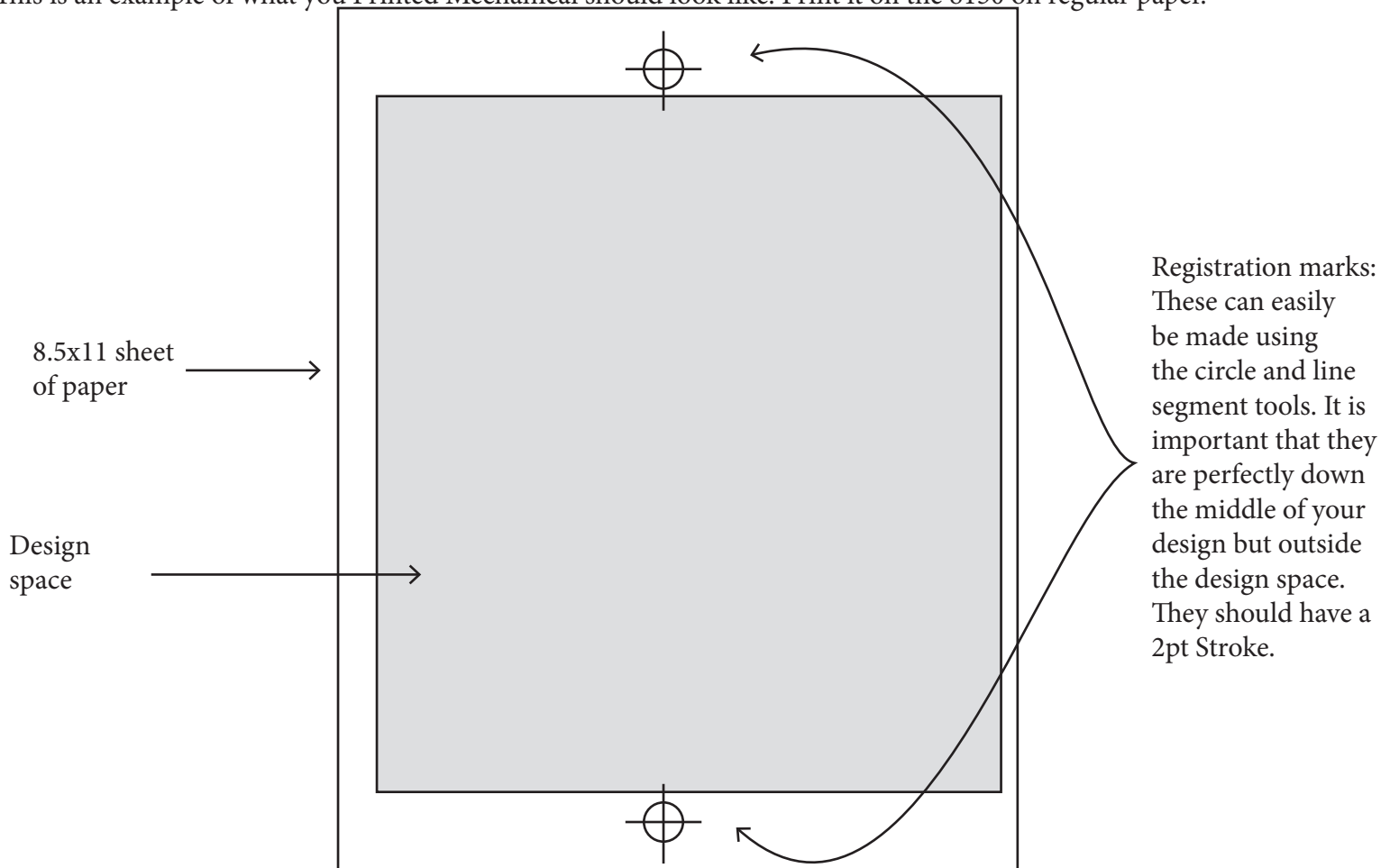
Must have text (outlined)

## What you will need to turn in:

1. Thumbnail Sketches
2. Rough Layout
3. Comprehensive layout
4. Printed Mechanical (with crop marks)
5. Screen printed without crop marks

**\*Option:** You can work with one partner and make an 8.5 x 11 inch two screen design.

This is an example of what your Printed Mechanical should look like. Print it on the 8150 on regular paper.
