

LETTER PHOTOGRAPHY



For this assignment you will be creating an entire alphabet (A-Z) out of pictures. After you have created an entire alphabet you will then use these letters to create a picture that spells your name (either first or last name).

Create photos of every letter of the alphabet. Go for the largest variety of objects, colors, and angles

- all images must be photographed by you (no internet images), you are not allowed to create images by moving objects.
- make sure the letter you are photographing takes up the entire frame.
- when you are shooting your pictures, it is helpful to write down all of the letters of the alphabet and scratch them off your list as you take pictures of them rather than going out and looking for the numbers in order.
- no repeating objects (example: using the same object to depict a T and an X)
- no taking an image of something that was meant to be a letter (example: taking a picture of a letter from a sign)
- remember, changing the angle of something you are looking at can completely change an image.

ADJUSTMENTS

Use 4 different adjustments from the adjustment panel. Create a word with your letters and try different adjustments. You must try 4 different words.

Try to match the feel of the images and the meaning of the word with the adjustments.

Watch the adjustments example in class.
