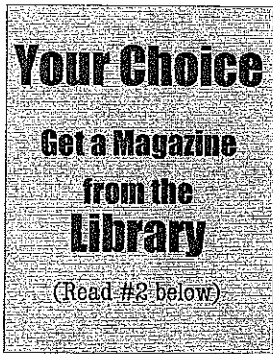


Recreating a Magazine Cover with + +

1. Choose one of the 4 magazine options shown below.

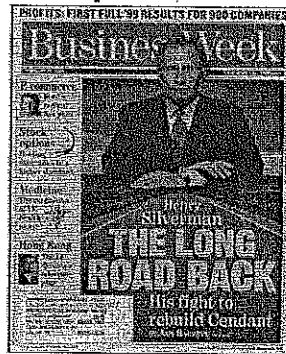

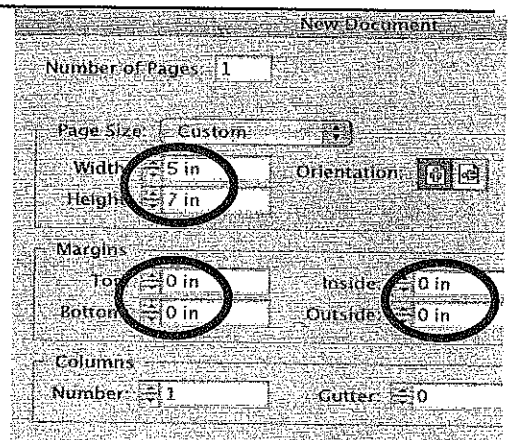

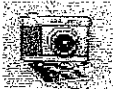


- Option 1 requires approval from the teacher and a minimum of 2 photos in the layout. The magazine must also be handed in with the assignment (use a manila folder). --> Magazine is returned to you after final grading.
- Re-create the magazine cover (identically) in a smaller format using ,  and photos you shoot:  
- Models of options 2 thru 4 are in the **GC_Magazine Covers** folder on the GraphicsComm server.
- Read the Project Instructions below **CAREFULLY**:


Project Instructions: Read steps 1 thru 9 carefully before starting.


- Make a new folder. **File** menu > **New Folder**.
Name the folder this way. --> **Magazine_YourName**.
NOTE: --> Put every file used for this project in that folder.
- Magazine Cover dimensions: Match the **New Document** setup. -->
- Use photos which YOU photograph [REQUIRED] using a digital camera or Photo Booth. Background images do not have to be photographed.
- Use  to layout the magazine cover's words and images.
- You **may not** utilize actual People, Sports Illustrated or Business Week logo images from their websites.
- Fonts must match as closely as possible in style and color. --> Utilize the **Font Book** -->  for help.
- The finished mechanical must match as closely as possible the original magazine cover.
- Go to the **Setting up Digital Photos** section on the next page after you have shot the photos for this project and for any other images you use for this project.
- Go to the **Print Setup** instructions on **page 3** of this packet before printing.





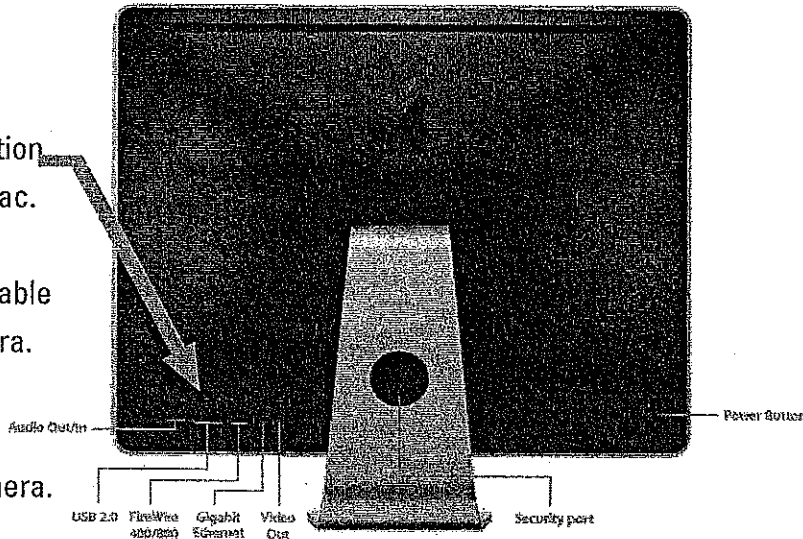
Using Image Capture to move photos on to the iMac

1. Have your digital camera and its cable ready before you go on.
2. Find  (Image Capture) on your dock and **double-click** it to make it launch.

3. This displays -->  after you launch **Image Capture** indicating a camera is not yet connected. Keep reading.

4. Find the USB connection on the back of the iMac.
5. Plug in the camera cable and turn on the camera.

6. **Image Capture** will connect with the camera.



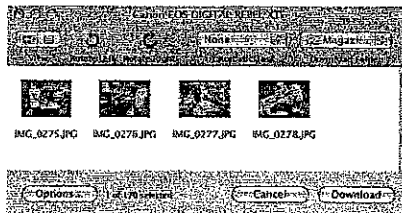
7. If the application "iPhoto" begins to launch, as quickly as you can, **QUIT** iPhoto — then continue to #7 below.

7. Click the **Download To:** menu and navigate to the **Magazine_YourName** folder as circled here: -->



8. Now click  to view the photos stored on the camera.

9. Click on the photo(s) you need and then click the  button.







10. After downloading, click **File** menu > **Quit**.

11. Go on to the next page of this packet --> to continue working with the photo(s) you downloaded.

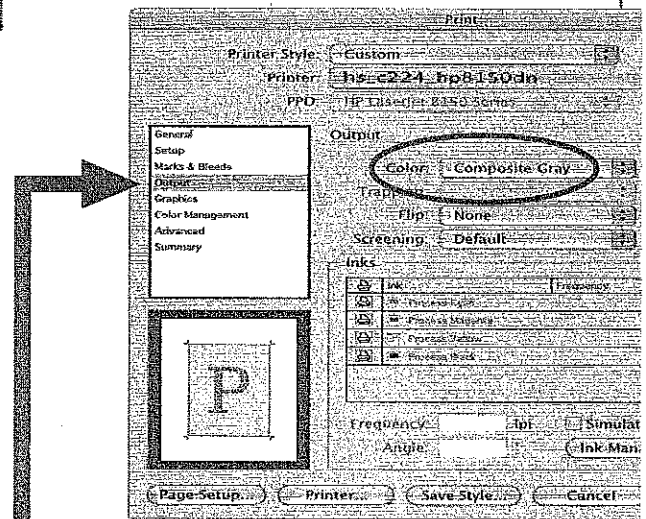
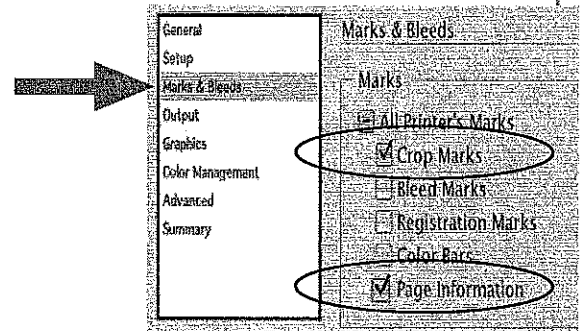
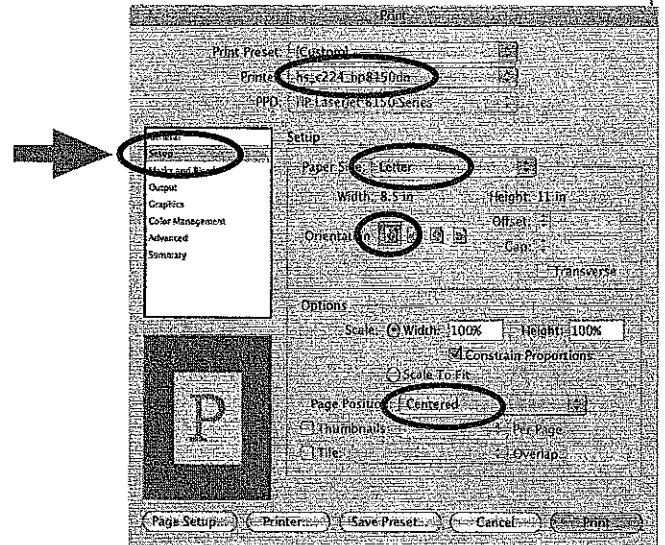

Setting up Digital Photos for the Magazine Cover in

After you have downloaded the picture(s), follow the steps below to prepare them for use in your Magazine Cover.

1. Move the photos onto your desktop.
2. Launch the first photo in .
3. After the photo opens, use the **Crop Tool** in the Toolbox. 
4. Drag the **Crop Tool** to designate the area of the image you need. See the example here. ---> 
5. **Double-click** within the cropped area when you are satisfied with the cropping.
6. Click on the **Image** menu > **Image Size...** If you want the image to cover the entire magazine cover dimensions, change either the width and height to be at least **5" Wide** or **7" Height**. Click **OK**.
7. Now click the **Image** menu > **Mode**. Change it from **RGB Color** to **CMYK Color**.
8. Finally, click on the **File** menu > **Save As...** Change the **Format** to **Photoshop (psd)**. Click thru the **OKs**. 
9. Quit Photoshop or repeat the steps above for the next image you need to prepare.
10. If your images need additional work, turn to the Image Acquisition + Manipulation page.
11. Now the image(s) are ready to be "placed" into your Magazine Cover. InDesign **File** menu > **Place...**
